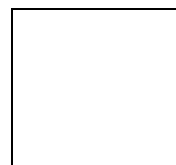

The Event

Marathon (including Devon County Championships)

An undulating 26.2 mile two-lap run in the shadow of Dartmoor. Start time 9.15 am. To qualify to enter the Devon County Championships, you must be a member of an affiliated club, must live or have been born in Devon and must not have competed in any other County Championships in 2008. There is no additional entry fee.

Half Marathon

An undulating 13.1 mile run in the shadow of Dartmoor. Start time 9.15 am.

10K Road Race

A fairly level 10k run into the Teign Valley. Start time 9.30 am.

Fun Run

An entirely safe approximately one mile run on the tarmac around Newton Abbot Racecourse. Start time 10.00 am. The run starts and finishes in front of the Public Stand and uses the tarmac ambulance track on the inside of the race track itself. We welcome entrants of any age, in fancy dress or otherwise. There will be an entrant limit of 1,200 so please enter early to avoid disappointment.

Charity

This is a fund-raising event, with all the surplus going to charity. We hope to obtain sufficient corporate sponsorship to mean that the donation included with your entry fee and any sponsorship you raise goes entirely to charity. In four years, we have helped raise over £50,000 for charity. We would be delighted if you would support our efforts by finding people to sponsor you.

Courses

The courses are between Kingsteignton (near Newton Abbot) and Chudleigh, in the shadow of Dartmoor. They are entirely on tarmac, with the start and finish at Newton Abbot Racecourse. New routes are being designed to increase the mileage in the countryside and reduce that in Kingsteignton. The races will be controlled by marshals, with drinks, sponge and aid stations, distance markers and time clocks. The courses are suitable for wheelchair users. Unofficial cyclists will not be permitted to accompany runners. All dogs and wheeled carriages other than wheelchairs are banned.

Organisers

This event is being organised by The Women's Running Network and The Rotary Club of Dartmoor Vale. Road Race Permits are being obtained from U K Athletics. The courses will be formally measured and certified accurate.

Prizes and Trophies

Prizes/trophies will be awarded to the first 3 men and first 3 ladies in the Marathon, the first 5 men and first 5 ladies in the Half Marathon and 10k. Prizes will also be awarded in the age categories M40, M45, M50 M55, M60 and M70, F35, F40, F45, F50, F55 and F60 dependent upon the numbers of runners in each category. Trophies are also awarded separately for the Devon County Championships. All finishers will receive a medal and memento.

Venue

Changing showers, toilets, refreshments and ample car parking at Newton Abbot Racecourse.

Entries and Entry Fees

Entry fees are shown in the relevant part of the entry form.

There will be a maximum entry limit for all races which are expected to be fully subscribed.

Closing date of postal entries is 10 October 2008 or earlier when maximum numbers are reached.

No Entries on the day

Joining instructions will be sent out early in September.

Time Limits

There will be a 5 hour time limit for the Marathon and Half Marathon and 2 hours for the 10K Road Race.
