

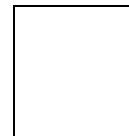


Dartmoor Vale 2005

The run starts and finishes in front of the Public Stand and uses the tarmac ambulance track on the inside of the race track itself. We welcome entrants of any age, in fancy dress or otherwise. There will be an entrant limit of 1,200, so please enter early to avoid disappointment.

Dartmoor Vale 2005

Newton Abbot Racecourse
Sunday 19 June 2005 from 9.15am



The events:

We are organising a Marathon (twice round a circuit), Half Marathon, 10 Kilometre Road Race and a Fun Run (approximately 1 mile around Newton Abbot Racecourse and therefore entirely safe for children). This will be only the second time a Marathon has been held in Devon since 1996. We are proud to be hosting the Devon County Marathon Championships.

Charity:

This is a fund-raising event, with all the surplus going to charity. We hope to obtain sufficient corporate sponsorship to mean that the donation included with your entry fee and any sponsorship you raise goes entirely to charity. In 2003 and 2004, we raised over £20,000 for charity. We would be delighted if you would support our efforts by finding people to sponsor you.

Course:

The course, unchanged from 2004, is between Kingsteignton (near Newton Abbot) and Bovey Tracey, in the shadow of Dartmoor. It is fairly flat, certainly by Devon standards. It is almost entirely on tarmac, with the start and finish at Newton Abbot Racecourse. The race will be controlled by marshals, with drinks, sponge and aid stations, distance markers and time clocks. The course is suitable for wheelchair users. Unofficial cyclists will not be permitted to accompany runners. All dogs and wheeled carriages other than wheelchairs are banned.

Organisers:

This event is being organised by The Rotary Club of Dartmoor Vale. We have had considerable support and advice from our local road running club, Teignbridge Trotters and have been in close contact with Devon County AA Road Running. Road Race Permits have been obtained from The South of England Athletic Association. The courses have been formally measured and certified accurate.

Prizes and trophies:

First 5 men and 5 ladies
First 2 in M40, M45, M50 and M60
First 2 in F35, F40, F45 and F50
Medal and memento to all finishers

Details of awards for the Devon County Marathon Championships will be provided to all entrants

Venue:

Changing, showers, toilets, refreshments and ample car parking at or close to the Racecourse.

Entries and Entry Fees

Entry fees are shown in the relevant part of the entry form.

Closing date for Postal entries– 11 June 2005. Entries will be accepted on the day with an extra fee of £2

Joining Instructions will be sent out in early May.

Time limit:

There will be a 5 hour time limit for the Marathon and Half Marathon; and 2 hours for the 10 Kilometre Road Race.
